Goal: 2 Corinthians 13:1-14

1. 2 Corinthians 13:1 (see also Deuteronomy 17:6, 19:15, Matthew 18:16) lays down a clear principle of Scripture. Was Paul going to be the one judging the local assembly?

2. What does Paul mean by “not sparing anyone” in verse 2?
3. In verse 5, Paul challenges the Corinthians to examine themselves as proof of Paul’s apostolic credentials. Why does Paul offer this as evidence?

How can we be sure this verse is not talking about personal assurance of salvation?

4. What is Paul’s desire and expectation of the assembly at Corinth? In other words, when he arrives, what does he hope they have accomplished because of his letter to them?
5. Verse 11 contains a thumb nail sketch of Christian living. Which of these exhortations is especially meaningful to you?
6. What makes verse 14 unique and special?
