**Sovereignty and responsibility found together** Rom. 10:20-21; Jn. 6:37

**Why does God choose some when all are sinners?** Eph. 1:4-5

**When is someone chosen of God?** Eph. 1:4; Rom. 9:11

**Why, then, should we preach the Gospel?** Mark 16:15; Rom. 10:14-15; 1 Cor. 9:19-22

**ELECTION:** klogē ek-log-ay'; (divine) selection (abstractly or concretely):--chosen, election.

'Chosen' in Acts 9:15; 'Election' in 1 Thess. 1:4

**PREDESTINATE:** proorizo pro-or-id'-zo; to limit in advance, i.e. (figuratively) predetermine:--determine before, ordain, predestinate.

'Determined before' in Acts 4:28; 'Ordained' in 1 Cor. 2:7; 'Predestinated' in Eph. 1:11

**FOREKNOWLEDGE:** prognosis prog'-no-sis; forethought:--foreknowledge.

Acts 3:12; 1 Peter 1:2; 'Foreknow' in Rom. 8:29; 'Foreordained' in 1 Peter 1:20
