1. Where was Paul held prisoner?
2. Verse 2 begins a parenthesis, or an aside, in Paul’s letter. Where does it end? What is the corresponding parenthesis in God’s plan for the ages?
3. Identify the mystery in this chapter. Is it the gospel? The church? Christ (or the Christ [Darby])?
4. Is verse 5 speaking of Old Testament prophets?
5. Paul says he is a minister of the gospel (in most translations). What is the meaning of “minister”?
6. What is the stewardship of God’s grace that has been given to Paul?
7. Whom does God use to demonstrate His wisdom to the angels?
8. What is meant by “every family” in verse 15?
9. To what do “breadth and length and height and depth” refer? What is broad, long, high, and low about it?
