### **Review**

**Opening Night** - Note we are not commended to a human leader or an organization, but to God, and then to His word. We are to value “the Book.” It is perpetually inspiring, powerful, and living. Hebrews 4:12

**Day 1**— God-Breathed — 2 Timothy 3:16-17 — Ps 33:6  
“cutting off ears”

**Day 2** — Reproof, Correction, and Rebuke = a life that displays God's glory and tells others who He is. Isaiah 66:2 "the motto of the believer". Example: Peter as one who was reproved. We will learn lessons all of our life. No one "arrives".

**Day 3 — God's Word encourages, comforts, and gives hope**

Seems to contradict with yesterday's theme. What things do we turn to for encouragement, comfort, and hope?

“you're not perfect”

“you'll never amount to anything”

“Have a nice day!”

“Great job!”

“just get over it”

#### **God's Word**

“For You formed my inward parts; You wove me in my mother's womb.”  
Psalm 139:13

“For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus...Ephesians 2:10

“I will never leave or forsake you”  
Hebrews 13:5

“you are precious in my sight” Isaiah 43:4

“For You are my hope; O Lord God, You are my confidence from my youth.”  
Psalm 71:5

“God helps those who help themselves.”

Other voices we chose...Music, movies, sports, political experts, entertainment culture.

Remember the word to Your servant, in which You have made me hope. This is my comfort in my affliction, that Your word has revived me. Psalm 119:49-50 NAS

...And stop assuming an outward expression that does not come from within you and is not representative of what you are in your inner being but is patterned after this age (*world*); but change your outward expression to one that comes from within and is representative of your inner being, by the renewing of your mind Romans 12:2 Wuest

**Hope equips believers for spiritual warfare 1Th 5:8**

**Hope enables believers to face the future with confidence**

**Hope assures believers of an eternal dimension to life 1Co 15:19**

**Hope enables believers to face death with confidence Ps 16:9-10** *See also Job 19:25-27; Ps 33:18; 1Co 6:14; 2Co 4:10-14; Php 1:3-6; Rev 1:17-18*

**Hope assures believers of their eternal life Ac 2:26-27; Ro 8:23-25; Tit 1:1-2; 3:7; 1Pe 1:3**
