2. What is different about what the Pharisees say to the Lord in verse 14 from what they have said in the past to Him as in verses 7:1-5 and 8:11?

3. What are we to learn from the question the Pharisees and Herodians asked the Lord in verse 14 and the Lord's response in verses 15-17?

4. What did the Sadducees believe as to spiritual matters?

5. What Old Testament scriptures are the Sadducees referring to in their hypothetical situation and question they ask the Lord in verses 19-23?

6. In verses 24-27, the Lord tells the Sadducees that they have errors in their thinking. What are the errors and how does the Lord correct them in what He says?

7. Does the scribe in verse 28 have a different attitude toward the Lord than that of the others that spoke to the Lord in this chapter? And if so, why?

8. What Old Testament scripture is the Lord quoting in verses 29-31?
