6. What is the difference in thought and attitude towards the Lord between the woman in verse 3 and those in verses 4 and 5?
7. In verses 6-9, the Lord defends and commends the woman for what she has done. What does He say that could encourage her? Does the Lord encourage us in a similar way at times when we do things for Him that are met with opposition?
8. What motivated Judas to do what he did in verse 10?
9. Why were the chief priests glad in verse 11?
