2. What is the leaning wall or tottering fence in verse 3? What is the contrast in verses 2 and 6?
3. What is the contradiction pointed out in verse 4? Can this ever apply to us?
4. What two things does verse 8 tell us to do?
5. Identify the things in verses 9-10 that are untrustworthy and the opposite of a solid rock.

6. What two things in verse 11-12 belong to God? How are they both displayed in Christ Jesus?

7. Are there certain experiences or times in life that can lead us to yearn for God as the Psalmist does here?

8. Verse 1 is set in desert; verse 2 in the sanctuary. What does this contrast help us understand?

9. How can this Psalm help us with anxiety problems?

10. What is the fate of those who rebel against the king?
