7. What is the source of satisfaction in verse 4?

8. How does the Psalmist portray God’s power? His goodness?

9. What do the heaving waves of the sea symbolize in verse 7?

10. Verses 12 and 13 describe the landscape itself filled with joy and shouting and singing. Can you think of other scriptures where creation experiences human emotions like this?
