LEADING UP TO THE CROSS

- John 11:49 – Caiaphas, unknowingly fulfilled scripture concerning the timing of the crucifixion
 - **Dan. 9:25-26**
 - John 12:31 – The Lord knew it was time to go to the cross to die and defeat Satan.
 - **Gen. 3:15**
 - Matt. 21:1-5 – Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey
 - **Zech. 9:9**
- Matthew 16:21 - The Lord knew He would be crucified and raised again the third day.
 - Matthew 17:22-23 - He knew he would be betrayed.
 - Mark 14:17-18 - He knew it would be one of His disciples that would betray Him. (John 13:26-27)
 - **Psalms 41:9**

- Matt. 26:24 – The price of betrayal had already been revealed.
 - **Zech. 11:12**
- Matt. 27:3-7 – The fate of the betrayal money had already been determined.
 - **Zech. 11:13**
- Mark 14:27-28 – The Lord knew all His disciples would be offended and run away.
 - **Zech. 13:7**
- Mark 14:55-56 – When they could not present any charges against the Lord, some lied about Him.
 - **Ps. 35:11**
- Matt. 27:12-14 – The Lord did not defend Himself at His trial or before Pilate
 - **Isa. 53:7-8**
- Matt. 27:26-31 – The Lord willingly was beat terribly and his body was mutilated
 - **Isa. 50:6; Isa. 52:14; Ps. 22:17**

Sometimes, the Bible tells us which prophecy is being fulfilled.

ON THE CROSS AND AFTERWARDS

- Gal. 3:13 – Jesus had to die on a cross to take the curse of sin from us.
 - **Deut. 21:23**
- Mark 15:27-28 – The Lord Jesus was hung between two thieves
 - **Isa. 53:12**
- Matt. 27:35 – The soldiers divided the Lord’s clothes and gambled for some of them.
 - **Ps. 22:18**
- Matt. 27:39-42 – The religious leaders made fun of the Lord on the cross.
 - **Ps. 22:8**
- Matt. 27:46 – The Lord Jesus cried out in agony, asking God why He had forsaken Him.
 - **Ps. 22:1**
- John 19:28-29 – Jesus cried for something to drink while on the cross
 - **Ps. 69:21**
- Luke 23:34 – Jesus died to make intercession for sinners
 - **Isa. 53:12**
- Luke 23:46 – The Lord Jesus commended His spirit to His Father
 - **Ps. 31:5**
- John 19:31-37 – Jesus was stabbed with a spear, but He had no bones broken
 - **Ex. 12:46; Ps. 34:20**
 - **Zech. 12:10**
- Matt. 27:57 – Jesus was buried in a rich man’s tomb.
 - **Isa. 53:9**
- Acts 2:31 – The Lord Jesus would be raised before His body could see corruption.
 - **Ps. 16:10**
