- Chapters 1-12 focus on the Apostle Peter and his work
- Chapters 13-28 focus on the Apostle Paul and his work

**Galatians 2:8, "For he that wrought effectually in Peter to the apostleship of the circumcision, the same was mighty in me toward the Gentiles. (Written by the Apostle Paul)"**

- The Church began on the Day of Pentecost (Chapter 2)
- Details Paul's three missionary journeys
  - 1st Missionary Journey: Acts 13:1 - 14:28 - Lasted 2 years - Traveled some 1, 235 miles
  - 2nd Missionary Journey: Acts 15:36 - 18:23 - Lasted 3 years - Traveled some 2,703+ miles
  - 3rd Missionary Journey: Acts 18:23 - 21:16 - Lasted 4 years - Traveled some 2,515 miles
