For I, the Lord, do not change; therefore you, O sons of Jacob, are not consumed. Malachi 3:6  
5<sup>th</sup> century B.C.

Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever Heb 13:8,

1. He is always true to his character. Lamentations 3:22-24, Heb 6:17,18, Ps 103:8
2. God always has a historical context in his dealings with us.
3. He warns before judgment. (Cain, Noah, Abraham)

Some of God's examples of Grace in the old testament.

1. Adam& Eve: Genesis 2:25,
2. Cain: Gen 4:9-15
3. Noah: preacher of righteousness Genesis 6
4. Abrahama: Genesis 15: 7-17, Deut 9: 5,
5. Other examples/scriptures: Ezra 9:13, Ps 130:8, 2 Samuel 24:14, Jonah 4:2, Micah 7:18

Promises of God's provision

1. Seed of the woman: Genesis 3:15
2. Isaac offered: Genesis 22: 1-14
3. Passover Lamb: Exodus 12
4. Servant of God/Sacrifice of Christ: Isaiah 52:13-53:12

3. Many *are* weak and sick among you . . . we are chastened by the Lord: 1 Cor 11:29-32

4. Chastening . . . for *our* profit: Hebrews 12:6-11
5. As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: Revelation 3:19
