“The things that are seen are temporal, but the things that are not seen are eternal” (2 Cor. 4:18)

A. The Context of 2 Cor. 4:18—Suffering and Persecution

1. Other people: How do you view people around you?
“Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God” (1 John 4:7).
“Diotrephes loves to have the preeminence” (3 John 9).

4. Reading material: What kinds of books/magazines do you read?

“Many ... brought their books together and burned them” (Acts 19:19).

6. Clothes: What styles do you wear?
- “They were naked, and they sewed fig leaves together and made aprons” (Gen. 3:7).*
“God made coats of skins and clothed them” (Gen. 3:21).
“I covered you with fine linen and silk ... but you trusted in your own beauty” (Ezek. 16:15).
- a. Provocative?
 - b. Designed to accentuate outer beauty?
 - c. Modest? (1 Tim. 2:9)
 - d. Designed to accentuate inner beauty? (1 Pet. 3:4)

*“Lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven ... for where your treasure is,
there will your heart be also” (Matt. 6:20,21).*

*Ten reasons not to look at pornography or read sexy romance novels:

- 1. Unscriptural (Lev. 18; Matt. 5:28-30).
- 2. May lead to even worse sins (2 Sam. 11).

3. Causes boy/girl friend, fiancé/fianceé, or spouse to disrespect and/or distrust you, thus creating severe marital problems.
4. Produces unrealistic expectations concerning relationship with one's own spouse.
5. Gives false view of ideal body type, leading to dissatisfaction on both sides.
6. Destroys communion with the Lord and ability to worship Him properly (Matt. 5:8).
7. Destroys prayer life (Psa. 66:18).
8. Destroys ability to discern the Lord's will (Matt. 6:22,23; John 7:17).
9. Makes effectual service for the Lord impossible (Matt. 6:26).
10. Ruins testimony before the unsaved.
